## **Autumn Learning Journey**

Year 7- Salvation History/Jewish beliefs and practices: Students begin by studying the history of our living faith. Judaism is the religion of Jesus and the foundation of where our faith grew from.

Year 8- Tradition and Vocation/Signs of Catholic Identity- Students have an opportunity to examine Christian practices and beliefs.

Year 9- Islam/Ethics & Philosophy- Year 9 begin by studying the life and practice of another religious community.

Year 10- Origins & Meanings- Year 10 are looking at different beliefs about the creation of the world, sanctity of life, stewardship and Catholic social teaching.

Year 11- Life and Death- Year 11 are studying different beliefs about life after death, sacred artefacts and funeral rites.

KS3 classes have knowledge organisers with keywords and activities that they must complete every fortnight.

Year 10 have revision guides and work is set from them each week to be completed at home dependently.

Year 11 have banks of past exam questions to be completed each fortnight and access to resources on the shared portal.
