Father Owen writes,

Carrying on from last week's Gospel with the Samaritan woman at the well – the people around Jesus still do not see the bigger picture. They still have the hardened hearts that will not allow the Holy Spirit to enter and illuminate their eyes.

We are over half way through Lent and we could easily place ourselves in the shoes of the authorities and not see, just looking on as hapless bystanders or we can become the woman or the man born blind and actually be open to the workings of the Holy Spirit and in turn open to the life being offered to us by our loving Father. It is so easy to go one way or another. But each way, has either life and hope to offer or blindness and despair. The choice is ours! Do we want to accept or do we want to control?
