#### **FR OWEN WRITES:**

In the last few weeks, being at home supporting family with treatment and all that is attached with that, I have learnt that wisdom is not knowing everything, wisdom is being weak enough to ask questions, to seek answers and to accept those answers even if they aren't the ones you want. True wisdom in faith and in hope is knowing when to be weak, it's knowing when to abandon yourself in God's arms at the times when it hurts the most, when it's the darkest moments of your life, and to learn to cry out Abba (Father). **BAPTISMS IN WYTHENSHAWE:** As we announced we have brought in some new particulars regarding the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism. I know that the need to produce a letter of practice from a priest cannot always be easy to get but when we are talking about making sure the sacrament is valid then you will agree that it is worth it. Baptisms from the 1st Sunday of Advent will now absolutely require such a letter from the parish priest of the Godparent's Roman Catholic parish. If one is not presented, then the Baptism will be postponed. For far too many people in the present time the point of Baptism is the party that comes afterwards. This is not a valid reason and will lead also to a postponement. I hope that you understand this change in operation as it means we are securing the sanctity of the Sacrament of Baptism.
