Father Owen Writes:

Welcome to this week's Newsletter. 'The world as we know it is passing away'. This tag line for the second reading this weekend is very apt. there are changes coming thick and fast not just in the readings but also here in Wythenshawe. In the readings we have scriptures leading us to the calling of the first disciples as written in Mark which we all know become the first bishops of the Church. But the Lord does not call people of royal or aristocratic families – no he calls simple (Ordinary) people to come follow Him and become fishers of men. A calling which is made to every priest from the moment of realisation. A calling to humility and love. A calling to acceptance and hard work. A calling to set oneself apart from the noise and the chaos of society to the silence of the Heart of Christ.

Just as there is change and calling in the scriptures, we also have in our parishes. We lose Father Stephen in just over a week's time and we welcome Fathers Robert and David to our parishes.
